There is today no little evidence and it is encouarging that in considerable degree the younger generations of white southerners are considerably less preoccupied with fear of the spectre of Negro equality than are their elders."

So strong is the Negro's desire for self-respect and dignity, Dr. Bunche indicated that "he is even willing to walk to work on masse to preserve that dignity, as he did for a long time in Montgomery, Ala."
