

## 'New' Negro Replacing Stereotype, Says White

CHICAGO—A "new" Negro who forms a sizeable part of the Nation's economic future is described by NAACP Secretary Walter White in September Negro Digest as replacing the shuffling, poverty-stricken stereotype of minstrel days.

"The average white American is seldom permitted to see this new side of the Negro picture by newspapers and other general media of mass information," White, who is a syndicated columnist for the New York Herald Tribune, says.
