A careful analysis of her tardiness in working out a solution is that the major ones go untouched or an investigation begins after they have reached their full growth.

In motive we believe they are pure, in introspection careless, in judgment poor, in Americanism doubtful. We say that the Coroner's Grand Jury was pure in motive in giving auggestions towards preventing future friction because the very fact that they have given suggestions proves that they are desirous of creating permanent amicable relations between the citizens of Chicago. We say that they are careless in retransaction and introspection because they have careless in retrospection and introspection because they have failed to make an intelligent investigation into the proximate causes of the great Chicago riot. The abstract fact of the drowning of a colored boy at the 26th Street Eathing Beach and the attempted invasion of colored across an arbitrary and imaginative dead line which they say caused the riot was no more the cause of the Chicago riot than was John Brown's raid the cause of the Civil War.

It has caused shourst difficultiveness to be emphasized and variet conscious. arate distinctiveness to be emphasized and racial consciou ness to be increased, in Alabama, Georgia and Texas where aggregation stands, 33 lynchings have been staged in the last fve months. 50 per cent more than occurred in 1885 when Segregation and Jim Crows were not in vogue.

To live as brothers in this Democratic country is our desire. To make a more perfect union is our desire. 
