

'New Negro' Drive To Be Discussed

CHICAGO (AP) — "The New Negro" is the theme of a national meeting of Catholic Interracial Councils at the University of Detroit Aug. 24-27, with scheduled reports to show the rise of Negro pride and leadership, officials here said.

Matthew Ahmann, executive director of the National Catholic Conference for Interracial Justice, said students participating in sit-ins and "freedom rides" are "giving witness to the dignity of every individual person."

"By and large, these movements have had good effects," he said.
